

Count Me In Too

The dissemination funding built on the Count Me In Too research and relationships to generate sustainability in the University-Community relations. Count Me In Too is an award-winning research project where lesbian, gay, bisexual and trans (LGBT) people shared their views and experiences, and worked with service providers and others to gather and present evidence that would promote positive changes for LGBT people.

Furthering the dissemination activities for this project Dr. Kath Browne and Leela Bakshi presented at numerous conferences locally, nationally and internationally. They also used the opportunity to draft a 'Count Me In Too book', which will be a key dissemination point reaching academic and community audiences (due 2012). This book will also ensure that there is a lasting legacy for Count Me In Too by detailing the key aspects of methods and methodologies required for meaningful 'community engagement'.
